Jr Blazers Spring Hockey 2025

Jr Blazers spring hockey is designed to provide hockey players with the opportunity to play hockey in the spring once the regular hockey season is over.

Spring hockey is not a continuation of the regular season. Players must tryout to make a team in spring hockey.

The season begins at the end of March and runs into May. The season can go as far as the May long weekend, depending on the tournaments that each individual team attends.



Jr Blazers Spring Hockey 2025

Spring teams are formed with players in their own birth year, compared to two or more birth years in the regular season. We intend to have teams in the following birth years for the 2025 season. 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017

*If the interest is there, a 2018 team will be considered.

For female spring hockey, players will play in the same division as the 24/25 regular season. We intend to have female teams in the following divisions for the 2025 season. U11, U13, U15, U18. Registration numbers will determine if we can hold a team in each division.

*If the interest is there, a U9 team will be considered.



Jr Blazers Spring Hockey Program Details

Each team will receive a minimum of two ice times per week. It could be weekdays or weekends depending on the ice allocation that we receive. There is no league play in spring hockey so most ice times will be practices focusing on player development.

Teams can attend a maximum of 2 out-of-town tournaments.

Special permission is required if teams wish to attend an additional tournament.

We intend to hold two teams in most age groups for the 2025 season. The registration numbers will determine the number of teams for each age group.



Jr Blazers Spring Hockey Tryout Process

Tryout dates are scheduled for December 30th and January 2nd. The tryouts will consist of game evaluations. Each player will receive two tryout sessions. These dates are for all age groups, including females. Tryout times and locations will be posted once we can confirm the number of players in each age group.

The head coaches will be responsible for running the tryouts and team selections. The head coach will submit the roster to KMHA for approval.

If a player is unable to attend the tryouts on the tryout dates, it is the responsibility of the family to inform KMHA so the head coach has time to evaluate the player during regular season play.

*The head coach may evaluate all registered players during regular season and tournament play leading up to the tryouts.

\$50 Tryout Fee – Due at registration

\$350 Jr Blazers Spring Hockey Fee - Due March 1st

*The spring hockey fee is only for players who are selected to a team.

There will be additional team fees to pay for the following items.

These fees will vary for each team.

- Tournaments
- Skills coaching (skills, power skating, goaltending training)
- Team Apparel
- Any other items each induvial team decides to purchase.
