



Female Rep

New for the 2026/2027 Season – U11 Female Development: KMHA intends to host a U11 Female Development team. This team will operate in the same manner as other Rep teams, with the expectation of competing in a dedicated OMAHA league. U11 Female Development and U11 Female Recreation will be separate streams, with players registered in one program or the other.

KMHA also plans to host Female A Rep teams at the U13, U15, and U18 levels:

U13 Female A: A Kamloops-based team operated by KMHA. All registration and tryout fees are paid to KMHA.

U15 & U18 Female A: OMAHA Zone teams open to players across the region. These Kamloops-based teams are operated by OMAHA, with all registration and tryout fees paid directly to OMAHA.

Fees

Players selected to a Rep team will be required to pay an additional \$450 carding fee to KMHA, which helps cover increased costs such as additional ice time. Each team will also operate with a parent-approved budget to cover seasonal expenses, including tournaments, apparel, uniforms, and team activities.

Season Structure

Teams will receive two full-ice practices per week. One practice will be scheduled in the late afternoon or early evening, and the second will take place on a weekday morning at 6:00 AM before school. Practice times will remain consistent throughout the season. Teams will travel within the Thompson/Okanagan region for league play, with occasional games outside the region if required. Each team may attend up to three out-of-town tournaments and will host one home tournament.

Commitment

Rep is a competitive level of hockey that requires a significant commitment from both players and families. Attendance at all practices and games is expected, with exceptions for illness or injury. Families should carefully consider the time, travel, and financial expectations before registering.
